## Charlotte Post Davis

Charlotte Post Davis, 82, of Dorrance Township entered into eternal rest Wednesday, July 7, 2010, at her residence, surrounded by her loving family and her closest friend.

Born in Wilkes-Barre, she was a daughter of the late Charles and Florence Smith Post.

Charlotte was a veteran of the Navy, having served three years during the Korean War.

She was past commander of American Legion Post, Joan of Arc, and past president of WAVES National, an organization for Navy women. She was also founder and administrator of Davis Nursing Home, Mountain Top, a trustee of Christ United Methodist Church of Mountain Top and a member of the Eastern Star 140.

She served on the Board of Directors of Clearbrook Rehabilitation Center, was instrumental in establishing a Navy museum at Great Lakes, was past president of the Navy Women Foundation and served on the Board of Directors of the Great Lakes Naval Museum Association.

Charlotte was preceded in death, in addition to her parents, by her husband, William S. Davis; a son, Dr. William C. Davis; and her brother, Charles L. Post.

She is survived by her son, Robert Davis; daughters, Jennifer Davis and Charlene Davis; five grandchildren, two great-grandchildren; aunt, Lois Post; and several nieces and nephews.
