Stephen Witinski, 79, of Mountain Top, passed away Wednesday, March 3, 2021, in Wilkes-Barre General Hospital.

Born Jan. 2, 1942, in Hanover Twp., he was the son of the late Joseph and Mary Tomko Witinski and graduated from Hanover Area High School, Class of 1959. He was drafted into the Army and served in the [Vietnam War](#) and was the recipient of the Vietnam Service Medal and the Good Conduct Medal.

Prior to retirement, Stephen had been employed by the Luzerne County Correctional Facility for over 30 years. He was a member of the American Legion and St. Jude's Church, Mountain Top.

Stephen was a jack-of-all-trades, a handyman who could fix just about anything. He had a passion for hunting and fishing. He also enjoyed country music, old westerns, many cruises and most of all the slot machines at the casino.
